
Who Are You?

 - Your character / characteristics




Identity -Who is this guy?





 - His character / characteristics









- Who are You?
 - -Not "of the world" (John 17:14)
 - -Tent dweller (Heb. 11:9)
 - -Different banking system (Matt 6:19-21)
 - -Not in Prison, so, scattered (Acts 8:1, 3-5)
 - •G1289 diaspeirō sown / seeded
 - -Momentarily afflicted (2 Corinthians 4:16-18)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

- 1 Peter 1:3

To an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

- 1 Peter 1:4-5

- Who are You? ... Grateful (1 Peter 1:3-5)
 - -For great mercy (1 Peter 1:3; Eph 2:11-12)
 - -For new birth (1 Peter 1:3; Eph 2:8-9)
 - -For a living hope (1 Peter 1:3; 1John 2:17; Phil 1:21)
 - -For an inheritance (1 Peter 1:4; Rom 8:17)
 - -For the coming revelation (1 Pet 1:5; 1 John 3:2)
 - -For eternal security (1 Pet 1:5; John 10:27-29)

Who are You? ... Summary

- Recipient of God's revelation (Gospel)
- -Called and commissioned
- -Grafted into Christ
- -Elect exile who is momentarily afflicted
- -Grateful recipient of great mercy, a new birth, a living hope, an eternal inheritance, coming revelation, and eternal security.


