




How can we go about navigating the "optimal" level of separateness from the world? (e.g., government protest)

- We don't want the world to influence us, we should influence the world
- (New Christians ... tendency to withdraw / Stronger faith, easier to be in the world and resist)
- Obedience as we understand it / Honor Him / Not to please man or fear man
- Separation is not isolation, it's contact without contamination



- O Greater pressure (difficult times, many stressors and stresses)? 32%
- O Less pressure (life is going relatively smoothly)? 68%


